Notice of race

1. Venue and date

The event will be held on the bay of Ascona:

- **Dart:** from Friday, May 8 to Sunday, May 10, 2009
- **Tornado:** from Saturday, May 9 to Sunday, May 10, 2009

The regatta will be governed by the following rules:

1. The racing rules of sailing RRS 2009-2012 ISAF, including the additional prescriptions of Swiss Sailing,
2. The Notice of race,
3. The Sailing instructions,
4. Swiss federal law for inland navigation with local amendments will apply

3. Eligibility

The regatta is open to boats from all countries. Participants must be member of a national Class and member of a sailing club affiliated to ISAF. For Swiss competitors the amendments of Swiss Sailing to the eligibility code will apply.

4. Advertising

This event is a category C event (valid license necessary).

5. Entry procedure and entry fee

The entry form is available on the net: www.ycas.ch

Entries shall be received by the organizing committee no later than April 29, 2009.

A late inscription with supplementary fee at the Club on May 8 (Dart) / 9 (Tornado) is possible.

The following documents are necessary for the registration:

- Copy of the measurement certificate or certificate of conformity
- Confirmation of club membership or license
- Advertising license if applicable.
- Confirmation of a third-party liability insurance

The entry fee is Chf 100.- per boat.

The supplementary entry fee for late entries is CHF 20.-

Dart: for IDAS-Members entries can also be sent by Dart 18-registration card 2009 at the beginning of the season.

6. Race program

7. Measurement

All boats must have a valid and complete measurement certificate.

8. Scoring

The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply (Sailing RRS 2009-2012 ISAF).
With 5 to 9 (6 for Tornado) valid races, the worst result will be discarded.

9. Prizes

There will be prizes for the first three boats of each class.

10. Mooring and parking

For every boat a suitable place will be provided inside the Yacht Club Ascona.
Special parking lots will be assigned to the trailers.
There will be a designated parking area for cars close to the Yacht Club Ascona.

11. Liability and insurance

Competitors participate at the regatta entirely at their own risk (see RRS rule 4 - Decision to race).
The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

Each participating boat shall be insured by a valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of CHF 1'500'000 per event and valid for racing.
