Notice of Race

1. Venue and Date

The regattas will be held from Saturday, September 18 to Sunday, September 19, 2010 on the bay of Brissago.

2. Organizing Authority

3. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing RRS 2009-2012 ISAF.

4. Eligibility

The regatta is open to boats from all countries. Participants must be member of a national association and member of a sailing club associated with ISAF.

5. Advertising

This event is a category C event (valid license necessary).

6. Entry Procedure and Entry Fee

Online at www.swiss-sailing.ch (<http://swiss-sailing.fastforward.ch>)

Entries shall be received by the organizing committee no later than September 10, 2010

A late inscription with penalty fee at the Club on September 18 is possible.

The following documents shall be enclosed with the entry form:

- Confirmation of club membership or license
- Advertising license if applicable.
- Confirmation of a third-party liability insurance, covering at least CHF 1'500'000.-
- The Entry fee is: ChF 80.- (official dinner included).

The penalty fee for late entries is CHF 20.-

7. Race Program

6 races are scheduled.

8. Scoring

The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply (Sailing RRS 2009-2012 ISAF).

With 5 to 6 valid races, the worst result will be eliminated.

9. Prizes

There will be prizes for the first three boats.

10. Mooring and Parking

For every boat a suitable place will be provided inside the harbour of Brissago.

Special parking lots will be assigned to the trailers.

There will be a designated parking area for cars close to the harbour.

11. Liability and Insurance

Competitors participate at the regatta entirely at their own risk (See RRS rule 4 - Decision to race). The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta. Each participating boat shall be insured by a valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of CHF 1'500'000.- per event and valid for racing.
